

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES



The Development and Training team, with the help of the Construction team, led the training of all of our new members in the use of our tools. After two days of work, all of BUILD's members were trained and ready for the busy semester to come and BUILD's largest construction year ever building eight TAMCs



BUILD's first task of the spring semester was putting the finishing touches on five TAMCs that would soon be sent to Ukraine, Egypt, Nigeria, Kenya, and Kenedy County. Installing backsplashes, screwing in cabinets, and putting on the last layers of paint were a few of the final steps to prepare the TAMCs for mobilization day.



In 2025 BUILD has expanded the construction cycle to include work in the spring.

Construction has begun for two new clinics. The first is a veterinary clinic heading to Raymondville, Texas. This is BUILD's secondever verterinary clinic, and it is dedicated to Texas A&M's beloved former mascot, Reveille II. The second clinic will be sent to Jeff Davis County, Texas and is dedicated to former Corps of Cadets member and 2008 Texas A&M graduate, Airman 1st Class James "Adam" Lassiter. This clinic will be the only point of medical care in the community.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES



On February 19th, it was time to begin construction of our two new clinics. Even with freezing temperatures, there was still a great turnout from the BUILD team. During Weeks 1 and 2 of construction, BUILD members began the construction of the wall and ceiling frames and installed subflooring. Also during this time, Britt Rice Electric and Benjamin Franklin Plumbing donated their services and installed the electrical and plumbing for our clinics.



Weeks 3 and 4 were all about preparing the containers for wall installation. The first step was to prepare the wall panels of our clinics. BUILD members routed, sanded, and painted 90 plywood panels. With this step finished, the team installed insulation and blocking to support the cabinets that are soon to be installed.



BUILD also welcomed volunteers from Aggieland's great student body. In just a few weeks, around 400 volunteers joined in on the BUILD project. By the end of Week 6, that total will reach over 800. BUILD volunteers work closely with Command Team members and are essential to the construction process and efficiency of the project.

On February 28th, our Texas Aggie Medical Clinics stood in College Station one last time before embarking on their journey to communities in need. Thanks to the leadership of our Operations Team Lead, Piper Klein, and the dedication of our members, we executed a seamless transition—loading the clinics onto trucks and transporting them to Houston. There, Medical Bridges will equip each clinic with essential medical supplies.


